Starting July 9th, we will be offering 5 different art camps this summer. Each camp is Monday—Thursday with a morning session from 10am–12pm and an afternoon session from 1–3pm. These are separated in grades 1–4 and grades 5–8. Our weeks include Painting Week and Drawing Week which are specific to those techniques. We also have 3 themed weeks which will include multiple mediums. These weeks include Zook Week, Pirate Week, and Wizard



Week. We hope to have class in person, but are set and ready to provide a kit for the week and have class virtually if necessary.
