

Plymouth Festival of Fine Arts

The Plymouth Arts Center is hosting its *4th Annual* Fine Arts Outdoor Festival. We invite you to apply!

ELIGIBILITY: This Fine Arts Festival is open to all artisans 18 and over who exhibit work of original concept, design and execution. Cash awards totaling \$500. We are accepting applications now until February 29th or until full. All entries will be reviewed by the jury committee. Jury will review entries the first week of March.

MEDIA: Two & three dimensional original fine art media including, but not limited to: painting, pastel, photography, pottery, drawing, fiber, jewelry, glass, ceramic, metal, wood, leather, sculpture, and mixed media.

APPLICATION FEE: A \$15 non-refundable fee is due with this application by February 29th along with four images of your work and one image of your booth in CD form **ONLY**. Juried acceptance notification and contract will be mailed to you.

BOOTH FEE: By **MARCH 30, 2012**. A \$60 booth fee is due *if application is accepted*. **No refunds after acceptance/no rain date refunds**. All fees benefit Plymouth Arts Center, a 501(c)3 non-profit organization. **PLEASE NOTE: You may send both checks at the same time. We will return the \$60 booth fee check if not juried in.**

ACCOMODATIONS: *Limited housing, in private homes is available to artists at no cost. Please visit Plymouth Chamber of Commerce for a listing of area hotels and B & B's: <http://www.plymouthwisconsin.com/lodging.html>*

APPLICATION PROCESS:

1. Please submit the form along with 4 images of your work and one image of your booth in CD form ONLY. Photos will not be accepted.
2. Enclose the non-refundable application fee of \$15 payable to the Plymouth Arts Center and mail to: Plymouth Arts Center, P.O. Box 253, Plymouth, WI 53073
3. **Provide self-addressed stamped envelope for notification.**

EXHIBITION RULES: Artists retain all proceeds from sales and are solely responsible for collecting and reporting sales tax. Booths are 10' x 10'. The Plymouth Arts Center **will not** provide "pop-up" tents or tables. Each exhibitor is responsible for providing and assembling his/her own display and loading and unloading artwork. Set up time begins Saturday, June 16th at 6:00AM. All displays must be set up by 8:30AM; remain in place until 4:00PM; with removal no later than 6:00PM. Contract will include additional information.
