## ELIGIBILITY

An Invitation to all WISCONSIN professional artists and WISCONSIN residents for whom Fine art is an avocation. Must be 18 years and older.

Compositions from published material, other artist's work or from photographs not taken by the artist are not considered original. Photo-reproductions or prints of original work (such as giclees) are not eligible.

- Must be original and created within the last three (3) years.
- Wall hung art must be framed and wired for hanging.
- Must NOT have been shown before in Gallery 110 North.
- White or neutral colored mats, please.
- No diptychs or triptychs.
- Framed and floor display 3-D pieces not to exceed 6' X 6'.
- Wall-hung pieces not to exceed weight of 30lbs.
- Sculpture and floor display pieces must be light and stable enough to be easily carried by two persons.

## MEDIA

Open to all 2 and 3 dimensional fine art media including, but not limited to, pastel, painting, sculpture, graphite, drawing, photography, fiber, ceramics, metal, glass, wood, paper, jewelry, leather, printmaking and mixed media.

## JUROR

**Richard Daehnert:** Art Professor Emeritus, University of Tennessee, Knoxville BS, MS, MFA. Richard is a Studio Artist of stitched drawings on canvas and makes his home in Sheboygan, WI.

## AWARDS

**\$1000 in cash awards will be presented.** Awards will be determined at the Juror/Judge's discretion from the actual work.

## LIABILITY

All work will be insured by the PAC while in the care of the gallery. Artist is responsible for shipping and insurance costs to and from the gallery. Submission of this application form constitutes the agreement to all conditions listed in this prospectus.

## SALES

Artists are encouraged to place their work for sale. If a piece of artwork is sold, a tax deductible donation of 35% of the sale price must be made to the PAC by the artist. Sold work must remain in the gallery the entire length of the exhibition.

## ENTRY PROCESS ✓ boxes

- Complete application form.
- Include a CD, providing images as JPEG files no larger than 1MB each. Provide an image of each entry (up to 3). The order of entries on the CD must be the same as on the Application.
- Include \$25 entry fee (covers up to 3 entries).
- Postmark deadline for entries **April 8, 2011** (no exceptions)
- Enclose self-addressed stamped #10 envelope to mail juror results to you and a larger envelope if CD is to be returned.
