Dear Fellow Artist Friend:

I am coordinating a plein air paint out opportunity titled "Paint the Town, en Plein Air," with the idea of it being a fundraiser for the Plymouth Arts Center. I'm inviting painters to participate in this premier event for the Plymouth Arts Center and encourage you to share this invitation with your fellow artists. As you may or may not know, the Plymouth Arts Center is embarking upon a fundraising drive in order to remodel and expand the building, galleries and classrooms; providing opportunities for us all.

The paint out will take place on Thursday, September 30<sup>th</sup> through Saturday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>. There will be certain areas within Plymouth that I will outline as the painting locations. Participating artists will check in on Thursday morning to have their canvases stamped and return them by Friday evening at 5pm to be stamped *completed*. There will also be a Quick Paint on Saturday from 9am-noon where artists will check in by 8:30am and have until 1:00pm to return their painting, framed, wired and ready to hang for display. *All* paintings including those by the Thursday/Friday painters should be framed and ready to hang by 1:00pm on Saturday. The exhibit will be hung Saturday afternoon. On Saturday evening, October 2, from 6-9 pm we will present a gala opening party with wine tasting, hors d'oeuvres, live music, dancing and a **silent auction**. A 30% commission on all sales will go to the Plymouth Arts Center. There will be awards and a salon exhibit for the three top winners. This is a very brief outline of the event. Much more information will follow as we get closer to the actual date. Please see the enclosed invitation.

I sincerely hope you will join in this activity. Many of us have shown our work in Gallery 110 North at the Plymouth Arts Center and many have won awards. To band together as a group and be a part of this fundraiser will be a way of giving back and helping to insure the future expansion of the Plymouth Arts Center and Gallery 110 North!
